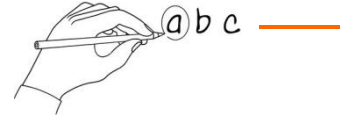




Much and many - ANSWERS

1. True or false?

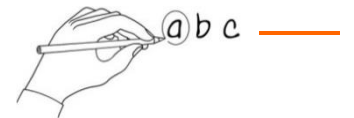
Read and circle true or false for these sentences.

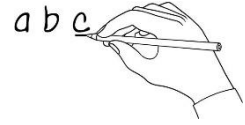
