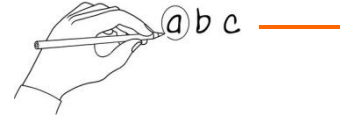





Present simple - verb 'to be' - ANSWERS

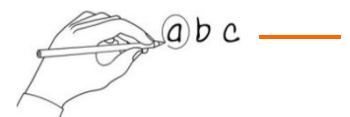
Read and circle true or false for these sentences.

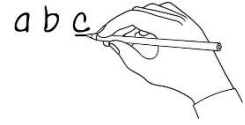
