

## Comparatives and superlatives

"The apple is bigger!"



### Examples

The cat is faster than the mouse, but the cheetah is the fastest.
The dolphin is more intelligent than the dog, but the chimpanzee is the most intelligent.

#### Remember!

We use comparatives and superlatives to compare things and to say which thing is top in a group. one syllable: small - smaller - the smallest

two syllables with y: happy - happier the happiest

two+ syllables: beautiful - more beautiful - the most beautiful

### Be careful!

The adjectives 'good', 'bad' and 'far' have special forms.


good - better - the best bad - worse - the worst far - further - the furthest
