



Comparatives and superlatives



"The apple is bigger!"

Examples

The cat is **faster** than the mouse, but the cheetah is **the fastest**.
The dolphin is **more intelligent** than the dog, but the chimpanzee is **the most intelligent**.

Remember!

We use comparatives and superlatives to compare things and to say which thing is top in a group.
one syllable: *small - smaller - the smallest*
two syllables with y: *happy - happier - the happiest*
two+ syllables: *beautiful - more beautiful - the most beautiful*

Be careful!

The adjectives 'good', 'bad' and 'far' have special forms.

good - better - the best
bad - worse - the worst
far - further - the furthest
