

'Going to' for plans

"I'm going to be a teacher!"



Examples

I'm going to be a teacher when I'm older. He's not going to play football anymore.

Remember!

We use 'going to' to talk about our future plans.

I'm going to write my homework tonight. They're going to watch a film this weekend.

Be careful!

You can usually make the negative in two ways.

He **isn't** going to ride a bike. He'**s not** going to ride a bike. They **aren't** going to visit us. They'**re not** going to visit us.
