

Much and many

"I've got many toys."



Examples

I've got **many** games. There isn't **much** time. Do you get **much** homework?

Remember!

Use 'many' for things we can count. Use 'much' for things we can't count. many computers / games / sweets much time / money / homework

Be careful!

In questions and negative sentences we use 'much', but we usually use 'a lot of' in positive sentences.

Have you got much water?

I haven't got much water.


I've got a lot of water.
