



Present continuous - future arrangements

"I'm visiting my friend."



Examples

I'm visiting my friend tomorrow.

They are coming to our house on Saturday.

Remember!

We can use the present continuous to talk about future arrangements - plans which you have organised.
I'm going to the cinema at the weekend.
What are you doing tonight?

Be careful!

For a plan which hasn't been arranged, we usually use 'going to'.


I'm going to watch TV after school. (This is my plan but I haven't organised it.)
