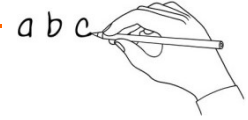
















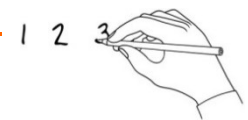
# The way to the park

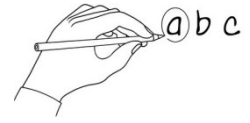
## 2. What's the order?

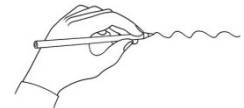
