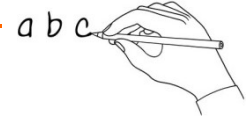

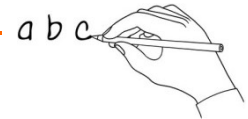


1. What's the word?

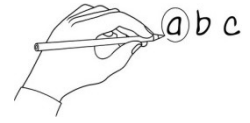


2. Where does it go?

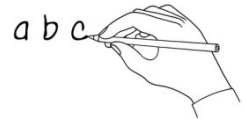
