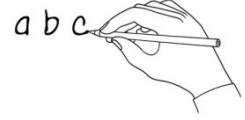




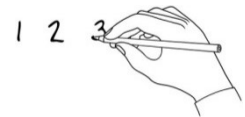
Why Anansi has thin legs! - ANSWERS

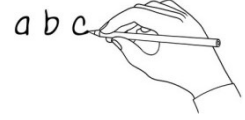
2. What's the order?
