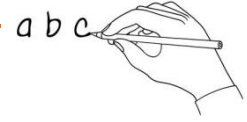

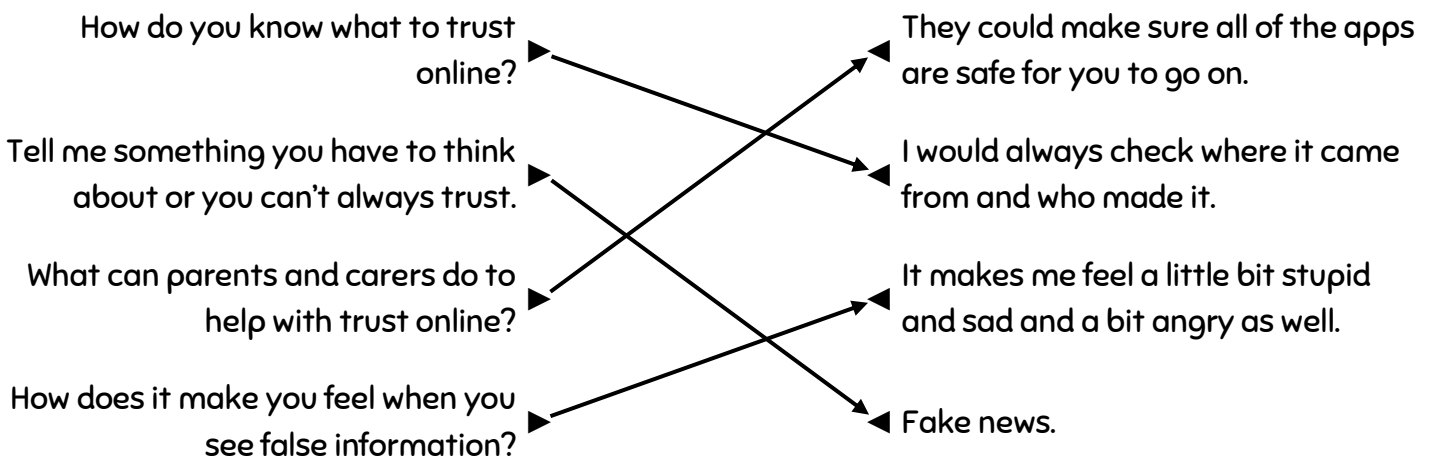

- Proof is information which shows that something is true.



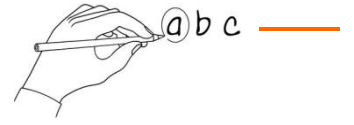
