a story which uses imaginary science or technology, for fantasy story example robots, aliens or time machines a story where some characters or abilities are impossible, mystery story for example a dragon or magical powers an imaginary story but one which could happen in real life biography a story where something strange happens and the informational book. characters have to find the answer ★a book with facts about a topic, for example animals, science fiction story science, history, etc. a thin book which tells stories with pictures and some traditional story writing, and there is usually a new one every week realistic fiction story a book about a real person's life a thin book which has lots of articles and photographs, and historical fiction story there is usually a new one every week or month a story which is set in a real time in the past but the magazine characters are invented or imagined a story which has existed for a long time, for example a comic fairy tale or a myth

Children write what types of books they like to read in the correct group.


